Thank you for your interest in the Virginia Master Naturalist program. The Peninsula Chapter is currently accepting applications for its Cohort 13 Basic Training Program from Class size is limited to 20 participants. Applicants will be notified of their status as soon as their application documents have been reviewed and approved.

The Cohort 13 Basic Training Program will begin in February 2018 and end with a graduation celebration in June 2018 (Exacts days have not yet been determined). Classes are held weekly on Wednesday evenings from 6-9 and are either at the Denbigh Community Center or the Virginia Living Museum. There are several required Saturday field trips so please make sure your schedule allows you to make this commitment.

The Virginia Master Naturalist Program is a statewide corps of volunteers who provide education, outreach and service dedicated to the beneficial management of the natural resources and natural areas within their communities.

The process for becoming a certified Virginia Master Naturalist volunteer typically takes 6 to 12 months. One starts by completing the 40-hour basic training course offered by a local chapter. In addition, each trainee must complete 8 hours of continuing education approved by either the state or local chapter. Finally, the trainee must complete 40 hours of volunteer service within a year of completing the basic training course. To maintain certification, each Master Naturalist must complete 8 hours of continuing education and 40 hours of volunteer service each year and pay the required yearly dues.
